#### **Attendance**

Being on time and attending school is very important. Occasionally, there may be a very genuine reason why your child can not come to school, usually sickness. The following percentages give you an idea of the impact of attendance up **until the end of Term 1**:

If your child has missed 4 sessions (2 days) their attendance is 95% If your child has missed 8 sessions (4 days) their attendance is 88% If your child has missed 16 sessions (8 days) their attendance is 80%

Over the year, there are 380 sessions and therefore as the year progresses, this gives a child the opportunity to improve their attendance. Mrs Rawlings has regular meetings with the Attendance and Welfare Officer for B&NES, to monitor and review individual pupil's attendance. If any issues arise regarding low attendance, the school will contact you. If you need support, please let the class teacher know.
