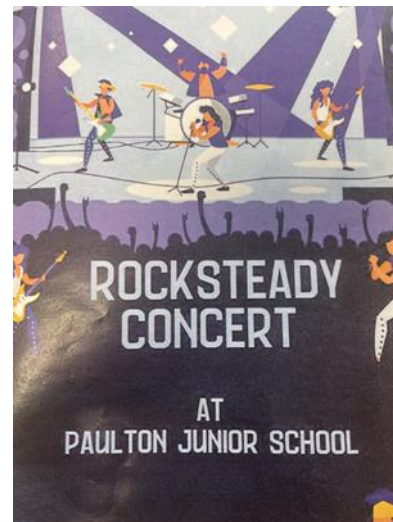
Would you like to be a school governor at Paulton Junior School?
